

Dear KEC Parents & Families,

In response to the Governor's announcement earlier today regarding COVID-19 (Coronavirus), KEC classes will be cancelled from Monday, March 16, through Monday, March 30. This includes all internships, clinicals, night classes, KEC activities and off-site classes. Students are to complete ALL Remote Learning assignments they received from their instructors at the beginning of the year unless there were updated assignments given to them this week (five assignments total). These assignments will be due the week we return to normal classes.

As I stated in my email regarding Remote Learning earlier this year, all students were given alternate assignments in the event that there were obstacles to completing their digital assignments.
