



KEC 2.0 Program

This program will follow all KEC policy and rules, which all students are required to follow, unless otherwise stated specifically.

Schedule

Students will be in session Monday-Thursday from 11:15 to 5:00 and Fridays from 11:15 until 2:15.

Students will arrive at KEC by 11:15 and will be provided with lunch if wanted. Students will then have their own daily individualized academic plan, in accordance with KEC and DHS staff. Students will be provided a second meal to have at KEC or to bring home with them. Transportation will be provided at 5:00.

Student Placement

Students placed in the 2.0 program, will be agreed upon and with KEC and DHS Administration. KEC staff will have a weekly check-in, and a monthly check-in with DHS, for updates on the students in the program. An assessment will be shared at the end of each semester, to make determination of placement for the following semester.

Areas to consider for the placement determination, are:

- Attendance
- Behaviors
- Work completion
- Participation in SEL group

Core work time

- Develop a curriculum that identifies gaps in student learning and allows for intensified content focus
- Create an independent style curriculum, creating projects for student work, such as art or computer programming

Attendance Grade

- Develop an understanding of how regular attendance impacts grades.
